

Update Your Skills or Learn for Fun with Fall 2016 Seminars or Short Session Classes

The following seminars or short session classes are offered through the School of Business, Technology and Trades to provide many opportunities for updating skills or just for fun! Seminars are graded (unless otherwise noted) on a Pass/Unsatisfactory basis instead of a letter grade, and credits earned are not calculated in the GPA. For most of the seminars, materials are furnished. These courses are offered in two to five sessions, all of which must be attended to receive credit for the course. No make-ups will be allowed. Seminars are one (1) credit unless otherwise noted.

REFUND POLICY: For a refund of tuition, students must drop seminars prior to the first class meeting or within the first two hours of the seminar. Students must complete the drop process by using MYVWCC at www.virginiawestern.edu. Once the deadline to drop for a refund has passed, a refund will not be issued.

SPECIAL NOTE: In the event of inclement weather or a college closing: Decisions to close the college for night classes or events will be made by 3 p.m. or closely thereafter; decisions to cancel day classes or events will be made by 6 a.m. or closely thereafter. Class cancellations due to weather or other college closing will be based on the time the seminar session is scheduled to begin for each meeting pattern.

- If your session begins at 4 p.m. or after, that session will follow college closings for night classes.
- If the session begins at 7 a.m. or after, that session will follow college closings for day classes.

MOTORCYCLE SAFETY RIDER COURSES

This course teaches basic physical and mental skills used in everyday riding. You will be taught basic skills of motorcycle operation, which includes turning, shifting, stopping, and straight-line riding. This course develops skills and street strategies necessary for safe and enjoyable motorcycle operation.

Upon successful completion of this class, eligible participants will receive a **VA DMV** motorcycle operator's license.

Equipment requirements: This basic rider course provides motorcycles and helmets. Students are required to wear protective clothing, eye protection, over the ankle shoes, sturdy full-finger gloves, long sleeve shirt or jacket, and long pants. **Students must be able to ride a bicycle.** Maximum enrollment is 12 people per session.

All classes meet in Business Science Room 245 on Friday from 6:00 - 9:30 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. unless otherwise stated below. Times are approximate and are subject to minor changes due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

RVH classes are NOT eligible for financial aid and CANNOT be audited. STUDENTS MUST BE ON TIME FOR ALL SESSIONS. LATE ARRIVALS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED.
