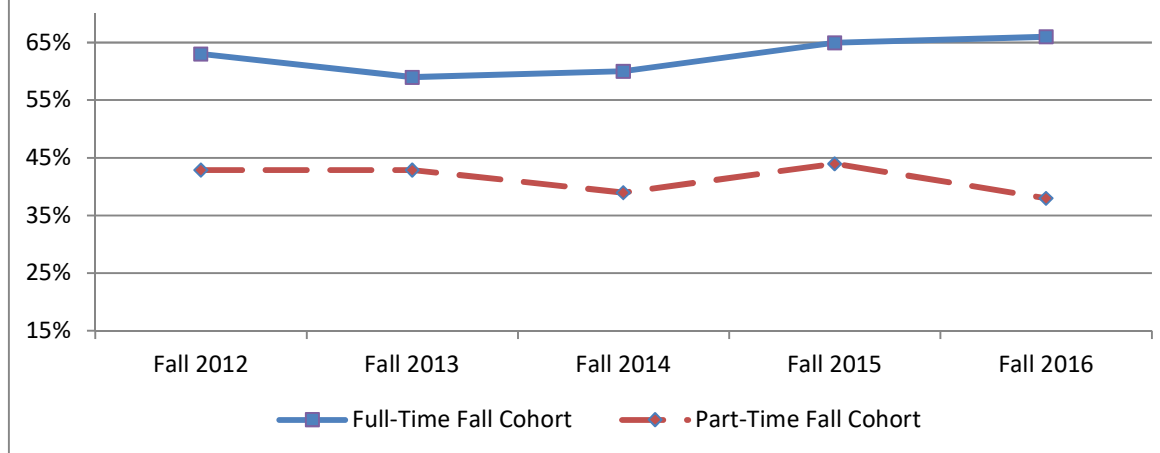


Cohort Fall-to-Fall Retention Percentages
