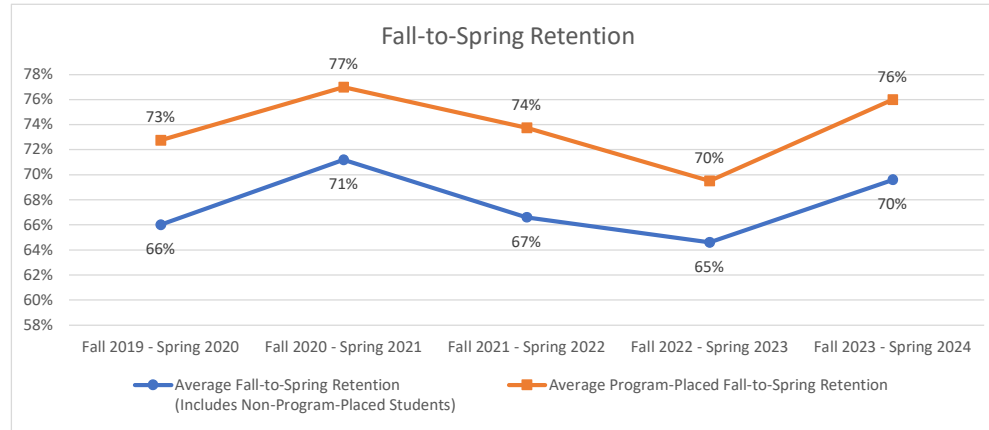


## Virginia Western Fall-to-Spring Retention Summary
